

# **Tampere Graduate Program in Biomedicine and Biotechnology (TGPBB)**

## **RULES AND PRACTICES**

Each member of TGPBB commits to follow the rules and practices of TGPBB according to his/her status either as a graduate student or a principal investigator of the research group.

### **GRADUATE STUDENTS**

Responsibilities of a graduate student are:

1. Follow the recommended curriculum of TGPBB and University of Tampere in theoretical and practical studies towards the PhD/MD PhD degree.
2. Commit to fulltime graduate studies.

Annual responsibilities to TGPBB:

3. Register at the university in the beginning of each academic year.
4. Organize a thesis committee meeting for the progress report on yearly basis.
5. Write a progress report for TGPBB every year.

Other responsibilities:

6. Inform TGPBB about the possible breaks in the PhD work (such as maternity leave, paternity leave etc.)
7. Inform TGPBB about foreign laboratory visits, courses and other foreign activities for the Academy of Finland reporting purposes.
8. List TGPBB as one of the collaborators (“suorituspaikka”) in the doctoral thesis.
9. Inform TGPBB about the date of your dissertation and the date of your graduation as a PhD

### **PRINCIPAL INVESTIGATOR OF THE TGPBB RESEARCH GROUP**

His/her responsibilities are:

1. Confirm commitments to supervise PhD works of the graduate students working in the research group.
2. Organize courses for TGPBB students.
